Primary Sport Funding (PSF) received: 2015-16

£8,245

How we used the funding (contributing towards):

- To lead the five Dorset special schools that make up the Teaching Alliance of Dorset Special Schools (TADSS) on:
 - Regular sports festivals, for instance: Rounders, Primary cricket, New Opportunities, and Football Challenge days
 - Hosting TADSS Beach festival 2016 (July 2016)
 - Costs include supply staff cover to facilitate attendance at events, hire of premises as required, etc.
 - Total Cost £10,832
- Additional swimming lessons above national curriculum requirements £2,460
- Contribution to provision of enhanced sports and play equipment in re-developed playground:
 - In-ground trampoline, roadway markings for bikes and scooters and football and basketball markings £1,700
- Swingball sets, scooters etc. for lunchtime play £630
- A comprehensive outdoor education programme above national curriculum requirements £5,500
- Primary Sports lunchtime clubs – multisports £1,000

How the Governing Body holds school leaders to account for the spending of PSF:

The Headteacher reports annually on how PSF has been spent in the previous year and the impact that it has had on pupil progress and wellbeing. Next review due 26/09/16

Outcomes for pupils of PSF: 2015/16

- 5 schools / approx. 40 pupils attending each festival
- 5 schools / 270 pupils attended Beach Festival
- Sensory needs of many ASD pupils met through in-ground trampoline
- More enjoyable lunchtimes and playtimes and road awareness opportunities
- Westfield fitness data demonstrates improving fitness levels for all pupils
- Agendas and minutes available from Schools Sport Forum meetings
