Dear Parents and Carers

Important information about the end of term

Since writing to you last week we have been planning our arrangements for the last few weeks of the summer term and looking ahead to the return to school in September. As I said previously, endings and beginnings are particularly important and we want to support our pupils as best we can.

We are now planning to have all pupils back to school for some days in the final two weeks of this term. We will be contacting you shortly about your child and when they will be able to come in to school. We are limiting the number of pupils in school to comply with social distancing guidance and safety measures.

Week beginning 6th July – we will have pupils back in two groups. One group will be invited in for Monday 6th and Tuesday 7th. The other group will be invited on Thursday 9th and Friday 10th. They will return to their **current class group**.

Week beginning 13th July – we will have pupils back in two groups. One group will be invited in for Monday 13th and Tuesday 14th. The other group will be invited on Thursday 16th and Friday 17th. They will go into their **new class group** where they will be in September.

Our **Y11 and Sixth Form leavers** will be invited in for a leaving event on the school field on Wednesday 8th July. We will contact you with further information about this.

We think it's really important for all pupils to start to get a sense of returning to some normality, but also to see friends and classmates and bring this school year to a close.

Some parent carers may not want their child to return to school just yet, and that is fine too. If you chose not to send your child in once you have been offered some days please let us know by replying to the email or phoning the school office.

We will contact you shortly to let you know which days your child can come in to school. We will also let school transport know which children will require transport on those days. Please note school transport is not guaranteed due to their own staff shortages. If no school transport is available we ask parents to make their own arrangements to support their child's return to school.

We are really looking forward to seeing everyone again.
